

Palette Wood Dye



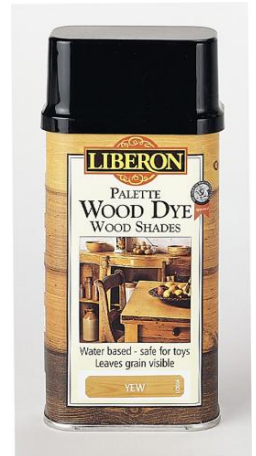
A water based, acrylic dye for colouring bare wood.

Purpose

Liberon Palette Wood Dyes are ideal for dying / colouring all interior bare wood work, whilst leaving the natural beauty of the grain visible. For use prior to oil, wax, varnish and French polish finishes they are suitable for both soft and hardwoods. Quick and uniform results can be achieved on large and small surfaces such as furniture, floors, doors, cupboards, frames etc and being EN 71 - Part 3 Approved they are safe for use on toys. Available in a range of wood shades, the different colours can be mixed together to create unique shades.

How to Use

Preparation

Assure the surface is thoroughly sanded, dry, bare and free from dust.

Application

Shake well before use. If more than one tin of dye is required to complete the work, mix the tins of dye together to ensure a uniform colour.

Apply the Palette Wood Dye fairly quickly along the grain using a foam applicator or brush. Wipe off excess with a clean, dry, cotton cloth before it dries to even out the colour. On large surfaces such as floors avoid overlap marks by working a small section at a time.

A second coat may be applied after 2 hours if a stronger colour is required. More than two coats of dye may affect the final finish.

Important: Always test product on a spare surface or inconspicuous area for colour, compatibility and end result. Different types of wood produce different results. The colour bar may not be a true representation of the actual colour.

Precautions

- Do not mix a water-based dye with a spirit-based dye.
- Wear gloves to avoid staining skin.
- Caution must be taken when using water-based finishes over Liberon Palette Wood Dye. Keep brush strokes to a minimum as over brushing may lift out the colour.
- Do not allow to freeze.

Colours: Ebony, Georgian Mahogany, Victorian Mahogany, Light Oak, Medium Oak, Dark Oak, Tudor Oak, Antique Pine, Golden Pine, Teak, Walnut, Yew, White

Coverage: 250ml = 2-4m²

Pack Size: 250ml, 500ml, 5L

Drying Time: Minimum 2 hours
